All the elements should be connected by different linking steps and by other skating movements using the entire rink surface.

Music must be recorded on CD.

For sub-goups, the organisation reserves the right to merge them in accordance with the number of entries.

Synchronized Skating and Ballet

Synchronized Skating

Collective discipline, the evolution on inline figure skates of groups of 8 to 16 skaters must be in perfect harmony and cohesion to skate in unison while executing circles, blocks, lines, wheels, intersections and step sequences to the rhythm of music.

Regulations are those of FFSG (G.O.E. and components).

Skaters must be in starting position within 15 seconds after announcement

Ballet

Ballet on inline figure skates is a transcript in space and duration of themes and arguments related to a musical text chosen by the coach and/or the choreographer.

Its quality is even greater as music, theme and choreography are consistent and give a feeling of harmony and creative emotional balance.

Duration : 3'00 (+/- 10'')

Skaters must be in starting position within 15 seconds after announcement

Judgement will be made on components basis

Important note: in compulsory and free dances, the judges will pay particular attention to the skating quality, the speed and the precision of the steps.

N.B.: candidates may compete both in couples and solo. They should specify on the entrance form.

ATTENTION : the skates used should have 3 or 4 inline wheels with a toe stop in the front
